In Internet Explorer, you can refuse all cookies by clicking "Tools > Internet Options > Privacy", and selecting "Block all cookies" using the sliding selector.

In Firefox, you can adjust your cookies settings by clicking "Tools > Options > Privacy".

In Safari, the path you follow is "Safari > Preferences > Privacy".

How to Delete cookies

You can delete cookies already stored on your computer; for example:

In Internet Explorer, you must manually delete cookie files.
